KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, Donald Lee
Barnett, Lyle L. Bullinger, Everett Scott Hartley Jr. and
Keith Eugene Gunn, citizens of the United States, each being over
the age of twenty-one years, and being desirous of forming a corporation
for the objects and purposes hereinafter specified and set forth,
do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming
a corporation for the objects and purposes hereinafter specified
and set forth, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose
of forming a corporation under and by virtue of Chapter 24:03 of
the Revised Code of Washington, relating to religious and charitable
corporations, and do hereby make, subscribe, execute, acknowledge and
adopt, in triplicate, the following Articles of Incorporation, and
io certify, as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Name and Object

Section 1: The name of this corporation shall be COMMUNITY CHAPEL AND BIFLE TRAINING CENTER

Section 2: The location and chief place where the activities of this corporation shall be carried on shall be in the City of Seattle. King County, Washington.

Section 3: The objects for which this corporation are formed shall be:

(a) To propogate the Christian Faith and to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ as revealed through the Holy Scriptures.

- (b) To erect and maintain a church building, social hall, business office, school rooms, parsonage and such other structures as are deemed necessary.
- (c) To engage in a ministry through radio, television, publications and other media of mass communication.
- (d) To acquire, operate and maintain Bible Schools, Orphanages, Homes for the Aged, and such other benevolent and charitable institutions as may be lawful under Chapter 24:08 of the Revised Code of Washington.
- (e) To acquire and hold real estate, and such other property as the realization of the aforesaid objects may demand.

ARTICLE II.

TERMS OF ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: Any person may be admitted to membership who confesses to the Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ and is a "born again" Christian as revealed by Holy Scripture.

Section 2: Voting rights shall be governmed by the Constitution of this Congregation.

Section 3: No person shall be admitted to membership who is actively affiliated with another church or who is associated with an organization or movement inconsistent with the Constitution of this Congregation.

ARTICLE III.

MANAGEMENT

Section 1: The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the Board of Elders consisting of four or more Elders. The Pastor, Donald Lee Barnett, shall appoint three members to the initial Board of Elders. The Pastor(s) will be ex-officio member(s) thereof.

Section 2: Additional Elders may be appointed by the Board of Elders.

Section 3: Elders are appointed for life, unless removed by a three-fourths vote of the others of the same office.

ARTICLE IV.

DUTIES OF BOARD OF ELDERS

Section 1: The officers shall consist of a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman who shall be appointed by the Pastor.

Section 2: The duties of the various officers shall be as prescribed in the Constitution of this Congregation, which may hereafter be adopted by the Congregation at its next meeting called for the purpose of completing the organization of this corporation.

Section 3: The Constitution of this Congregation, save as it may be in conflict with these Articles of Incorporation. or of State or Federal laws, shall be the governing law of this Congregation.

ARTICLE V.

DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution of this corporation the assets at the time of dissolution shall go to the closest local Chapter of Teen Challenge, if existing in King County, Washington. If no local Chapter exists then the assets are to go to the national organization of Teen Challenge, a non-profit, charitable organization located at 416 Clinton Avenue, Brooklyn, New York.

ARTICLE VI.

AMENDMENTS AND BYLAWS

Section 1: Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be made by a three-fourths affirmative vote of the Board of Elders and the original Pastor's concurrance, if still presiding.

Section 2: Bylaws not in conflict with these Articles or of the Constitution of this Congregation may be adopted at the next meeting called to complete the organization of this corporation, or at any subsequent meeting of the Board of Elders. The Bylaws or any provision of the Constitution may be amended in the same manner as amendments to these Articles.
